The Ruler from Bethlehem - Micah 5:1-6

When the wise men came to Herod to ask about the birth of a king, he asked the Jewish leaders about it. They paraphrased Micah's passage: "And you, O Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who will shepherd my people Israel" (Matthew 2:6). Micah prophesied that a new ruler would come sometime after the return of the remnant from captivity. From an insignificant clan of a tiny village come the greatest King of Israel, Son of David, who was from Bethlehem and a shepherd.

However, the leaders omit, whether intentional or not, two things about this king. First, this King is Eternal. His "coming forth is from of old, from ancient days" (Micah 5:2). John testified that "He was before me" (John 1:15). Jesus Himself said to his opponents "before Abraham was, I am" (John 8:58).

This King would be a Shepherd, who "...shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the LORD, in the majesty of the name of the LORD his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth. 5 And he shall be their peace." "Great to the ends of the earth." Even Gentiles, including some wise men from the east would know of His greatness. Jesus called Himself the Good Shepherd and said, "I have other sheep that are not of this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd." Now who could these "other sheep" be?

Interestingly, in Ephesians 2:14 Paul said that Jesus Himself is our peace (cf. Micah 5:5) as He described Jesus gathering the Jewish and Gentile sheep into one body: For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility (Ephesians 2:14).

Jesus of Nazareth fulfilled Micah's 700 year old prophecy. Does He fill your life as King and Shepherd? He can be your peace too.

Honoring our First Responders

"On Sunday, **September 9th**, we, the Hamburg Pike church of Christ, will set aside the day to say "thank you" to those who serve our community as first responders. Eric will present a sermon "Building Up First Responders," which is part of Eric's monthly "Building Up..." series approved by the elders.
